WELCOME REMARKS AND INTRODUCTION OF SPEAKER ROB FERGUSON AHEAD OF HIS ADDRESS TO LOCAL COMPANY PRESIDENTS AT THE WINSUPPLY STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETINGS MARCH 2020 | NASHVILLE, TENNESSEE
